## Top Tip

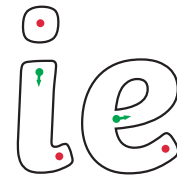
The grapheme 'ie' can sometimes make the /ee/ sound, e.g. field. We have previously learned that 'ie' can make the /igh/ sound.
