Adding **-ed** to words ending in **y**

When we add the **-ed** suffix to a word, it means the action has already happened.

Look at the letter before the **y**. Add **-ed** when it is a vowel before the **y**.

stayed

annoyed

Replace the **y** with an **i** when there is a consonant before the **y**.

hurried

copied

Adding **-ing** to words ending in **y**

When we add the **-ing** suffix to a verb, it means the action is happening now.

Add **-ing** to the root word.

carrying

studying

Common Exception Words

We have been learning to spell the common exception words **talk** and **two**.

Grammar

Adding **-ing** and **-ed** changes the tense of the verbs.

I am worrying.

I was worried at the weekend.
